LOCATION: "Where will we shoot? Do you pick or do we?"

The location that you choose isn't EVERYTHING, but it something that you can have a lot of fun with. Our images are focused on you and your family, but a great background adds a mood, color, texture and light. In general we shoot in either a natural space or an urban location.

Natural locations are open fields, a lovely garden, and treed areas.
Urban locations are cool alleys, buildings, and campuses.

YOUR KIDDOS: "How do I keep them calm? What if they don't smile?"

Photographing children is about a cheesy smile, but capturing their *personality*. That being said, we do suggest bringing snacks, toys and an extra outfit. Parents play a big role in encouraging the children to smile and be themselves.
